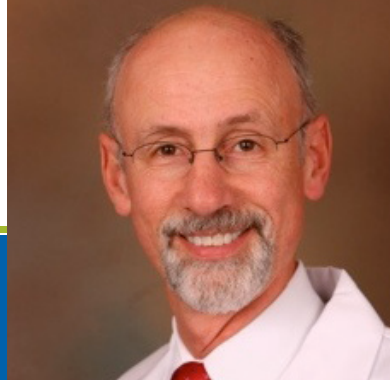

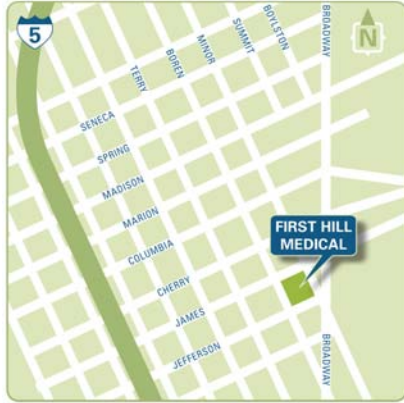
Personal Interests:
